Turkey Camp: Now Open for Registration!

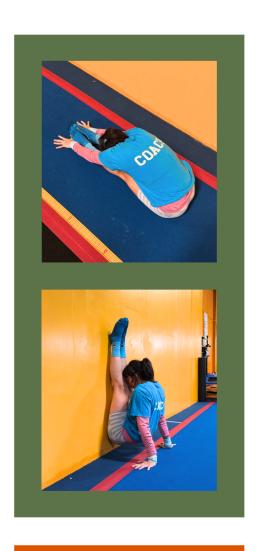
Turkey Camp is back November 24-26! Registration is now open, so don't wait to secure your child's spot for this popular holiday camp.

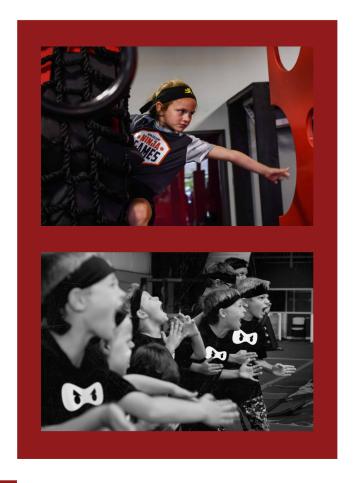
